- aged between 15 years and pension age
- an Australian citizen or permanent resident (or otherwise have working rights in Australia).

## Attend now to:

- Meet all your mutual obligation requirements. This activity is 25 points per week, which is your 100 points per month, not even job searching activities will be required.
- Reduce or pay your court fines. We will assist you to apply for a Work and Development Permit (WDP) to do this.
